Parents/Carers Meeting Arrangements

Parents/carers meetings are taking place next Tuesday and Wednesday. Please can we ask the following:

Everyone is to use the main entrance (office) when arriving and leaving school.

If your child is in Year 3 or Year 4 - please go to the hall where you will be able to look at your child's books. The class teacher will come and collect you from the hall.

If your child is in 5R - you will be able to wait in the other Year 5 classroom and look at your child's books.

If your child is in Year 6 - you will be able to wait in the spare classroom (opposite the Year 6 classrooms) and look at your child's books.

Junior Hub

As the Junior Hub is now full on some after school sessions, it is essential that if you want to book a session you give as much notice as possible.

Ad-hoc bookings

Please remember that these sessions should be booked, at the latest, by Thursday the week before. However, if you are unable to do this then you must telephone the school office (912-5005) by 2:30pm the day before e.g. if you want to book for your child for an after school session on a Wednesday, you need to telephone school by 2:30pm on the Tuesday.

If you telephone wanting after school session on the same day, your request may be denied or you will be charged an extra admin fee of £10.

The admin charge will start from Monday 18th November.

Cancelling a session

Unless your child is ill then we require at least 24 hours notice for a cancelled session otherwise we reserve the right to charge for the session missed.
