Years 3, 4, 5 & 6 - Choir on a Wednesday after school until 4:15pm. There is no cost.

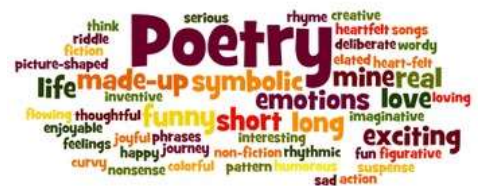
**Please sign up on ParentPay. When all of the places have been allocated, the club will no longer show as available.**
