Meet the Teacher

Attendance

It is important that the children attend school every day. This is important not just for your child's learning, but also for their overall wellbeing, wider development and their mental health. We know that there might be an occasion when your child is ill.

If your child is going to be absent, then you need to telephone the school office between 7:45am - 9:00am. As part of our attendance procedures, Mrs. Hall (Attendance Lead) will have a telephone conversation with you.

In August, the government brought in new guidance regarding children's attendance. The guidance is lengthy; however, it is important that you are aware of the main points and changes.

- If your child(ren) arrives after 9:20am (this is when the registers close), they will be given a U code. A U code is classed as an unauthorised absence.
- Holidays taken during term time will be unauthorised.
- If your child misses 10 or more sessions (5 days) for unauthorised reasons (within a rolling ten school week period), then an 'Education Penalty Notice' may be issued. The fines have increased and are issued to each parent/carer. Fines per parent/carer are capped nationally to two fines within any three-year period. After this, other action like a parenting order or prosecution will be considered.

Please remember that it is important that we work as a team and if there is anything that you need support with, please contact the school office.

Safety

We can assure you that the safety of the children is always our top priority. It is important that children are using the footpaths and do not walk across the car park without using the zebra crossing. Please can we ask that if you do need to use the car park to drive that you are aware of children and other pedestrians. **Nobody should stop or park on the zebra crossing.**

Please can I remind you that no dogs should be brought onto the school grounds, this includes the car park.

Please can I also remind you that no children should be playing on the gym equipment after school, either children who attend school or siblings/friends. We do not supervise it at this time & cannot ensure their safety.
