This week's learning highlights come from the school councillors in 6B.

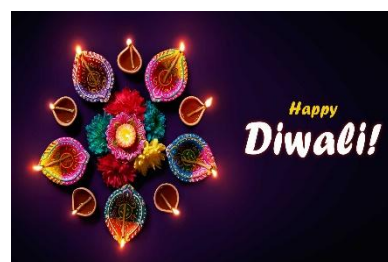
Hashim said that his highlight has been learning about the artist Frank Shepard Fairey and creating his own piece of art.
