**There is no choir on Wednesday 12<sup>th</sup> November.**

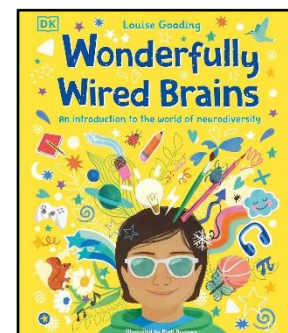
Parents/carers meetings are taking place next Tuesday and Wednesday. Please can we ask the following:
