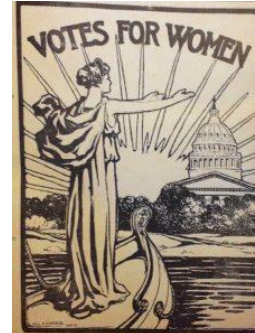




Home Learning Challenge
