The children complete their reading records and have the opportunity to earn golden weeks. They get a golden week by achieving all of their reading targets and getting 20 effort points when they complete a reading activity. When the children earn five golden weeks, they get a prize. If they earn 35 golden weeks, then they will receive a mystery prize!

Also there is a 'Reader of the Week' in every class and the children receive a certificate. There is also 'Reader of the Term' in every class. The 'Reader of the Term' receives a £5 book voucher.
